

RUSTIC GLAZED TREE FARM TRUCK



MATERIALS

CCX151 Coupe Dinner Plate (10") Goo Powders 2 Small dishes for mixing goo Screen Squeegee Tree Farm Truck Silkscreen Fan Brush Medium Round Brush Small Round Brush Liner Brush

COLORS

Underglaze Colors: CMM 31 - Licorice CMM 91 - Blue Ice CMM 90 - Red Hot CMM 67 - Snowflake Specialty Glazes: Mayco EL 132 Rust Red : Mayco EL 129 Slate Mayco EL 131 Turtle Shell Mayco EL 155 Holiday Green Mayco EL 105 Holiday Green Mayco EL 100 Mud Slide Mayco EL 101 Oyster Shell Mayco EL 103 Sea Spray

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INSTRUCTIONS

A little prep work to do before getting started (to make your life easier!)

We recommend mixing up your Goo before class. For this piece, you'll need Blue Ice Goo and Licorice Goo.

Add 2-3 Tablespoons of underglaze to your container. Add a hefty pinch of Goo Powders and stir to combine. Let the mixture sit for 5 minutes and stir again. If it looks like pudding it's ready to use. If it's too thick add more underglaze. If it's too thin add another pinch of Goo Powders and stir.

Step-By-Step...here we go!

1. Use Blue Ice Goo to apply the silkscreen to the top of the plate. We will use this as a guide for where to paint the glazes. Wash out your screen and let it dry, we will use it again for the final step.

For the remaining steps, you will use the design like a coloring book. You need to paint over the blue lines of the design as you go. This will ensure appropriate coverage and a cleaner final print.

2. Apply 2 coats of Rust Red Glaze to the truck body.

3. Allow the Rust Red to dry. Then, apply one heavy coat of Red Hot underglaze to the body of the truck (applying it directly on top of the Rust Red).

4. Use a small brush to apply 3 generous coats of Slate Glaze to the inside of the windows, the door handle, the tires, and the grill.

5. Paint the fence with 3 coats of Mudslide Glaze using a liner brush.

6. Working around the trees, use a medium brush to apply 3 generous layers of Sea Spray to the sky.

7. Fill in the headlights and the center of the hubcaps with 3 coats of Oyster Shell Glaze.

8. Use liner brush to apply 3 coats of Red Hot underglaze to the ring between the hubcap and the tire wall.

9. Paint the trees in the bed of the truck with 3 coats of Holiday Green Glaze.

Do not glaze this piece, just fire and admire!

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INSTRUCTIONS

10. Fill in the trees in the background with 3 coats of Turtle Shell Glaze.

11. Apply 2 coats of Snowflake underglaze to the ground.

12. Allow the Snowflake underglaze to dry, then apply a generous layer of Oyster Shell glaze to the ground (applying it directly on top of the Snowflake).

13. Thin down Snowflake under glaze with 50% water to 50% paint. Dip a medium brush in and splatte the plate to lok like snow.

14. Once the glazes are no longer shiny, you can use Licorice Goo to apply the silkscreen back on top of your design. Line it up as best you can, it is meant to be a little offset. The glazes are going to move and flow in the kiln, so we aren't aiming for perfection.

13. Use a fan brush to apply 3 coats of your desired glaze to the back of the plate.

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
